Food Pantry Donations

Andrews House maintains a **small emergency food pantry** for individuals in emergency situations or have exhausted other pantry options. In addition, we maintain a **Little Free Library & Pantry** on Winter Street in front of Andrews House which is accessible 24/7. This is an increasing need. When needed, we deliver pantry items to people.

Items we need for our pantry:

100% fruit juice drinks or electrolyte drinks

Canned fruit (pop-top) or fruit cups

Canned vegetables

Canned Tuna or Chicken (pop-tops are preferable)

Individually wrapped snacks like Nut Packets, Granola Bars, Protein Bars, Chips, etc

Shelf-Stable Milk

Rice or Ramen Noodle

Pasta and Pasta Sauce

Oatmeal packets

Pancake/Muffin Mix that only require Water

Pancake Syrup

Peanut (or other nut) Butter & Jelly

Canned Ravioli, Stews, Soup, & other heat-and-eat foods with pop-tops

Allergy friendly food options (gluten free, nut free, dairy free)

Coffee
